

Port Of Kemi Ltd. waste management

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Upon arrival to port of Kemi, the master of the vessel or an authorised person shall give the port a notification of vessel generated waste and cargo residues. The notification is to be given to the port security of Port Of Kemi by using the procedure confirmed by the Finnish Transport Safety Agency (Traficom). The notification must be given no later than 24 hours before arrival or, if the duration of the voyage is less than 24 hours, immediately upon departure from the previous port. If the port of call is known less than 24 hours before arrival, the notification must be given as soon as the port of call is known. This mandatory notification does not apply to vessels which have been granted an exemption by the Finnish Transport Agency from the obligation to deliver vessel generated waste.

In the port of Kemi, all waste from vessel is accepted only by subscription. The subscription shall be made to port security of Port of Kemi, phone number +358 40 5482 065.

If a notification of vessel generated waste and cargo residues is not given to the port authority and/or the waste has been delivered besides the waste disposal station, a fee of sorting and disposing the waste will be charged from the vessel.

There are five waste disposal stations in port of Kemi as well as one container for hazardous waste. The stations are located at the quays. The waste from a vessel is to be delivered to waste station and sorted correctly by the crew of the vessel. The port security of Port Of Kemi supervises and guides the vessel disposal.

There are separate waste bins for each accepted type of waste at the waste disposal stations. For each waste type, the bins are marked with coloured stickers according to the list below. The colour of the bins can be different than the colour of the waste type to be put in it.

- Biodegradable waste

- Glass
- Metals
- Mixed waste
- Paper
- Cardboard
- Paints and glues
- Solid oily waste



Oily bilge water as well as slew amounts of waste oils must be discharged to a waste collection vehicle of such waste.

International catering waste (category I) includes food scrabs and waste generated during the consumption or preparation of food originated from outside the European Union. Such waste must be disposed in a tightly closed container marked as "CATEGORY I, ONLY FOR DISPOSAL". The waste bin for such waste will be delivered to waste collection station upon request.
